AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FOR THE YOUTH SERVICES
BUREAU FUND 2307

WHEREAS, the City of Gary Youth Services Bureau was the recipient of a Health Issues and Challenges Grant in the amount of \$127,419 for fiscal year 2023 beginning July 1, 2023.
